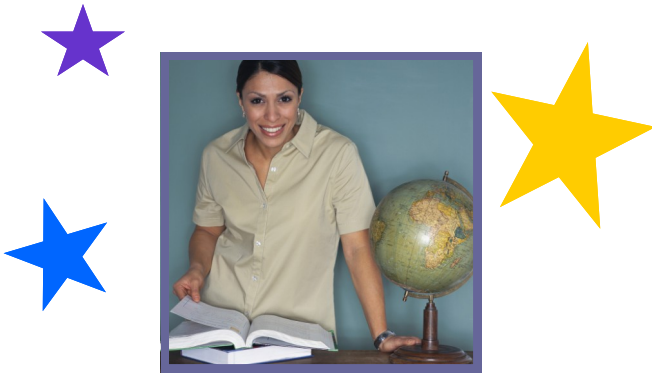

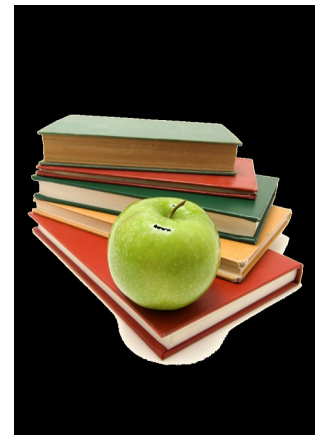

Kindergarten Complement



Kindergarten Complement is an extension of your child's traditional half-day kindergarten. The learning experience is enhanced through intentional lessons based on district curriculum and best practice for teaching children this age. Kindergarten Complement teachers work with classroom teachers to provide an enriching environment that reinforces skills learned during their half day kindergarten time. S.M.A.R.T. (Stimulating Maturity through Accelerated Readiness Training) is included in the daily kindergarten lesson plans. This curriculum is designed to provide strategies that enhance learning using appropriate activities that are fun and engaging to actively stimulate the brain.



Summer Kid Connection offers a variety of activities and experiences for children entering kindergarten through 6th grade in the Fall. Participants are divided into groups by grade to allow for age appropriate activity planning.
